

We are looking for you to explain your chosen method and interpret the results from your data to demonstrate your understanding of the test.

P: Personal Responsibility

Exercise personal responsibility in planning and implementing tasks according to prescribed protocols

B1: Work autonomously while knowing when to escalate appropriately and recognising limits of scope of practice.

We work within a system of 'off the shelf' packages. We ask you to follow these to carry out a range of tests or procedures associated with your role within a specified time frame. You will be asked to demonstrate your understanding of when you need to seek input from another. Your supervisor or others and when to escalate.

B2: Take responsibility for safe and sustainable working practices and contribute to their evaluation and improvement.

We expect you to demonstrate a range of behaviours which demonstrate responsibility for safe, ethical and sustainable working practices.

B3: Take responsibility for the quality of your work and also enable others to work to high standards.

This means that you can show how you are one of the quality standards and how you enable the work being carried out by you and others. You should be able to describe an example of how you enable these standards and ensure that they are maintained.


C: Interpersonal Skills

C1: Evaluate and demonstrate effective communication skills.

What we are looking for here is an example that you are an effective communicator. The example can be through carer contact, telephone, email or video conference.

C2: Demonstrate effective team working skills.

This means that you can demonstrate examples that you have worked effectively with others to interact with colleagues to provide the best patient care. This may include the way you work within the work setting. In these situations it



Code of Conduct and Practice

Demonstrate a personal commitment to professional standards.

E1: Comply with and promote relevant codes of conduct and practice.

This means that you can demonstrate a commitment to comply with a code of conduct (in a formal or informal capacity) and to promote all relevant legislative, regulatory and local requirements.

E2: Maintain and demonstrate a commitment to continuing professional development (CPD), reflecting the science principles of your discipline.

The Science Council CPD Standard requires registrants to demonstrate a commitment to the principles of Continuing Professional Development (CPD) and reflect on its implementation and effectiveness. We are encouraging registrants to collect evidence of how you have benefited from your professional development. Your CPD may include work-based learning, professional activity, formal/educational, self-directed learning.

(Note registrants will need to comply with the Science Council CPD Standards)
