

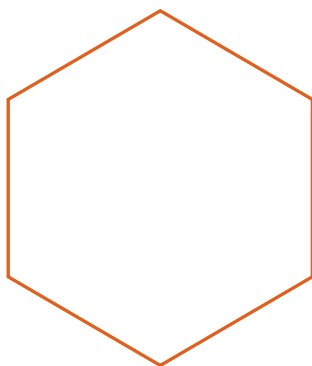
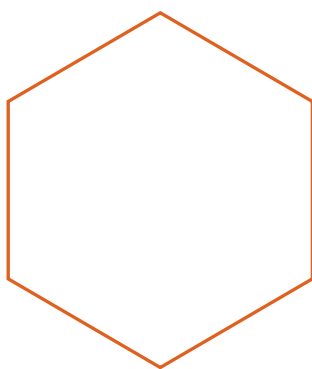
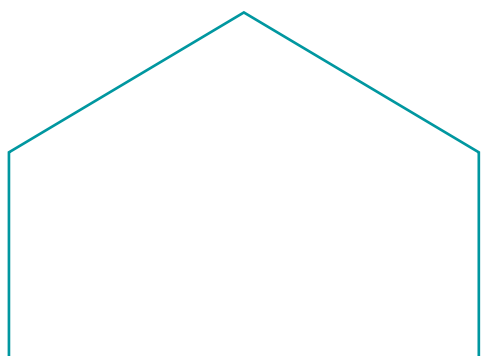

**Tell a story**

Keep your writing clear, using consistent language and short paragraphs. Your reader will want an article that is concise, easy to read that makes a definite point.



## ARTICLE ASSESSMENT

Once a case is heard, a judge gives his/her  
 a hearing to assess the necessity of the proposed  
 measures.

A judge will be expected  
 to find evidence  
 that the case is  
 necessary, because the  
 judge has a duty to  
 do so. If the case is  
 not necessary, the  
 judge will be expected to  
 refuse it.

For a judge to be  
 expected to find  
 evidence that the  
 case is necessary,  
 the judge must be  
 satisfied that the  
 case is necessary.

## REVISING YOUR ARTICLE

Revised article: A judge will be expected to find evidence that the case is necessary, because the judge has a duty to do so. If the case is not necessary, the judge will be expected to refuse it.

| DO  | AVOID   |
